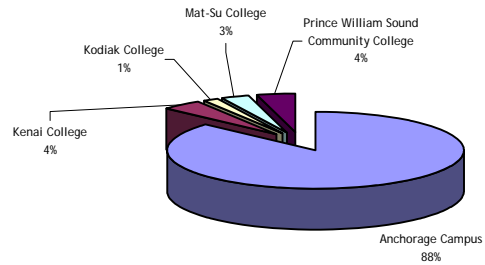

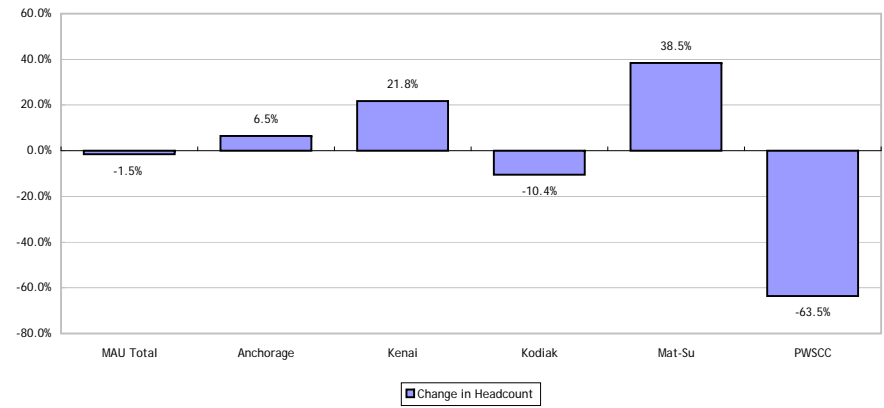

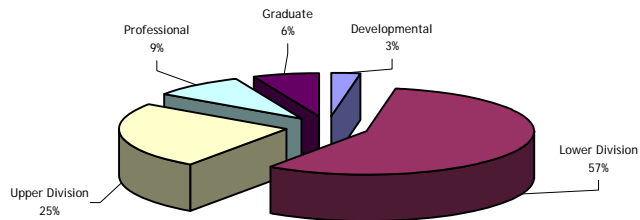
Credit Headcount by Campus, Summer 2008



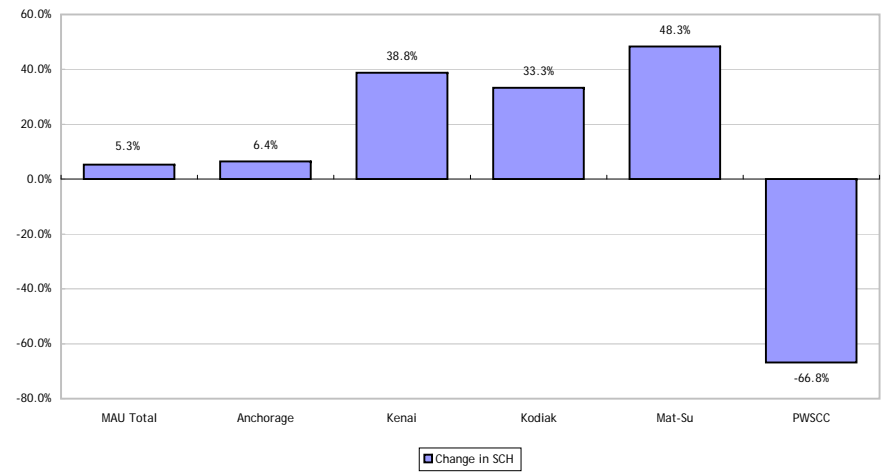
**% Change in Credit Headcount
