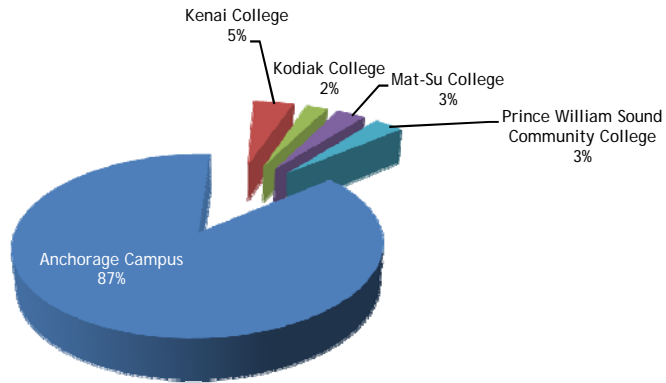

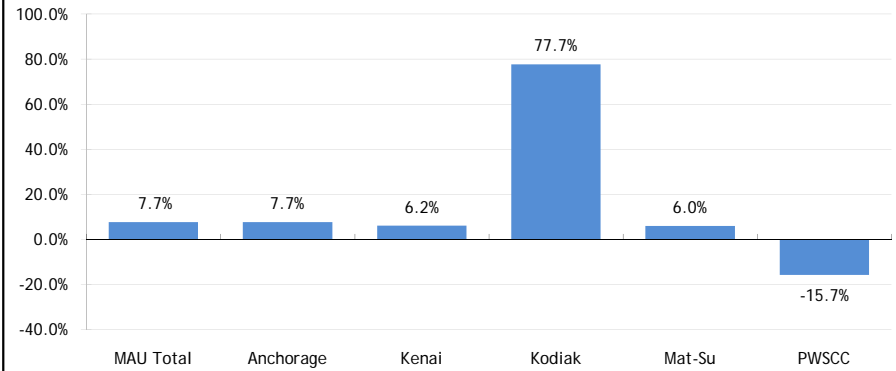

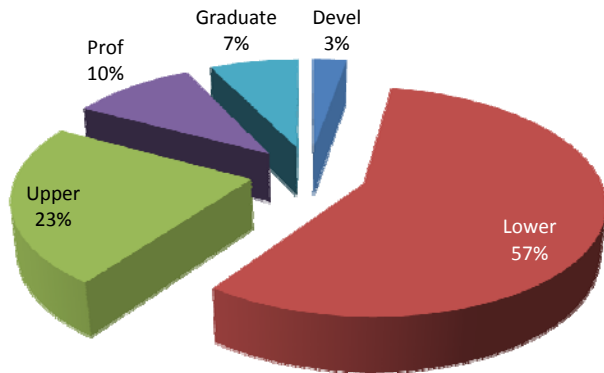
Credit Headcount by Campus
Summer 2009



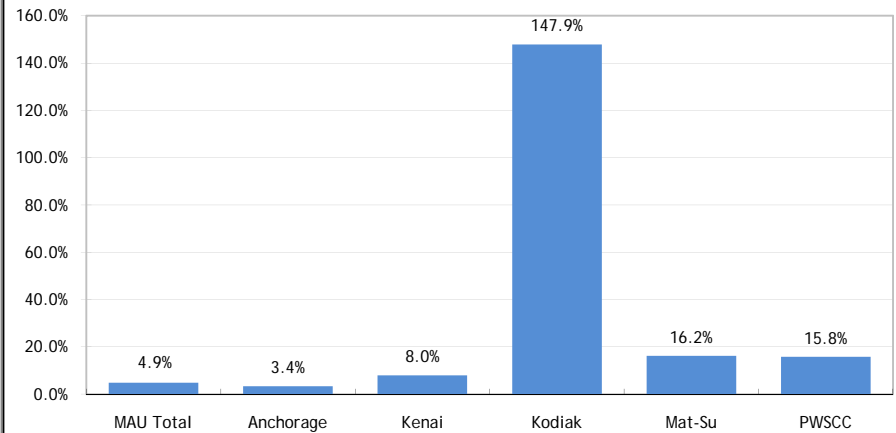
% Change in Credit Headcount

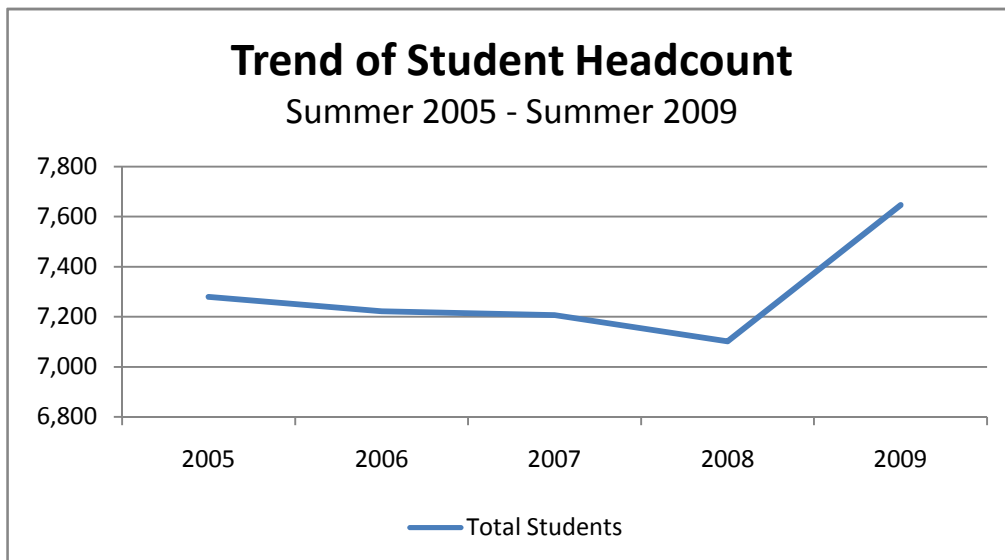

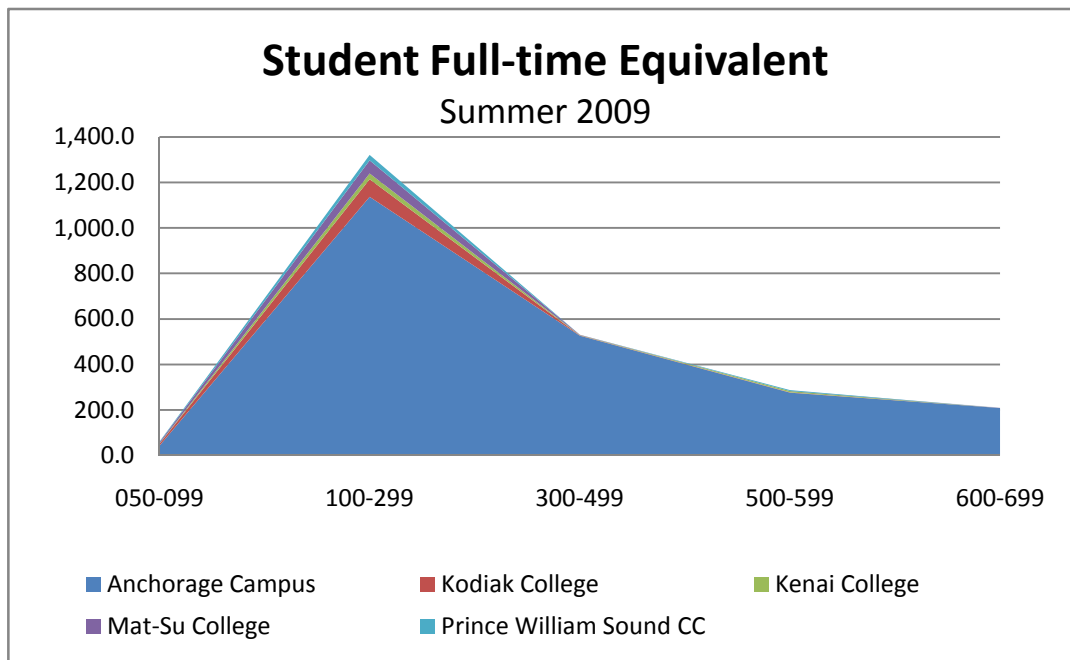
