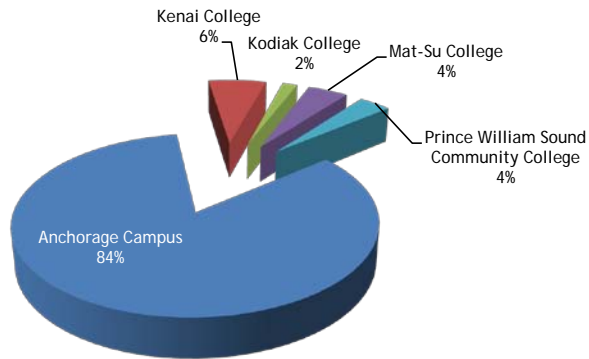

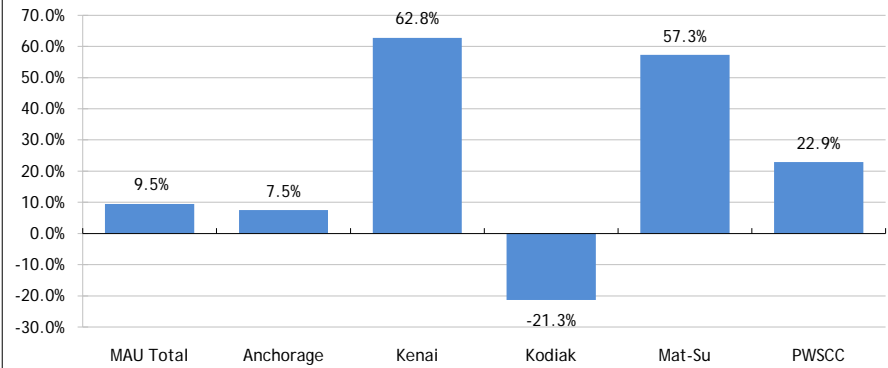

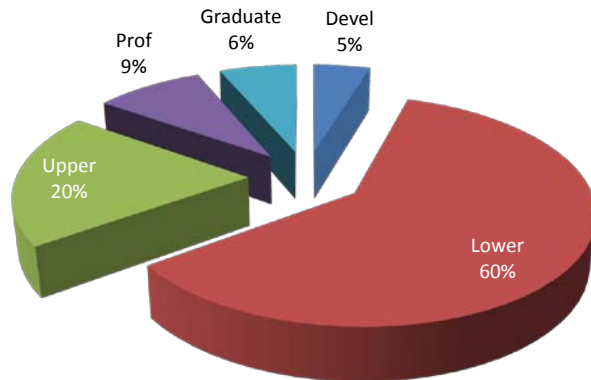
Credit Headcount by Campus
Summer 2010



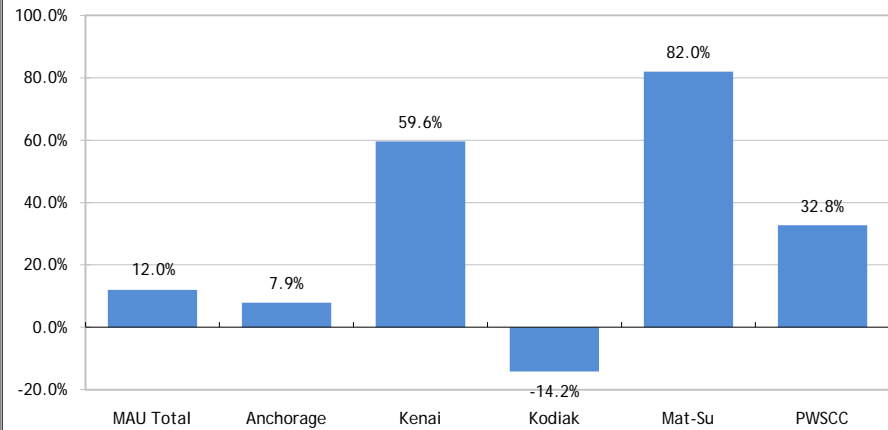
% Change in Credit Headcount

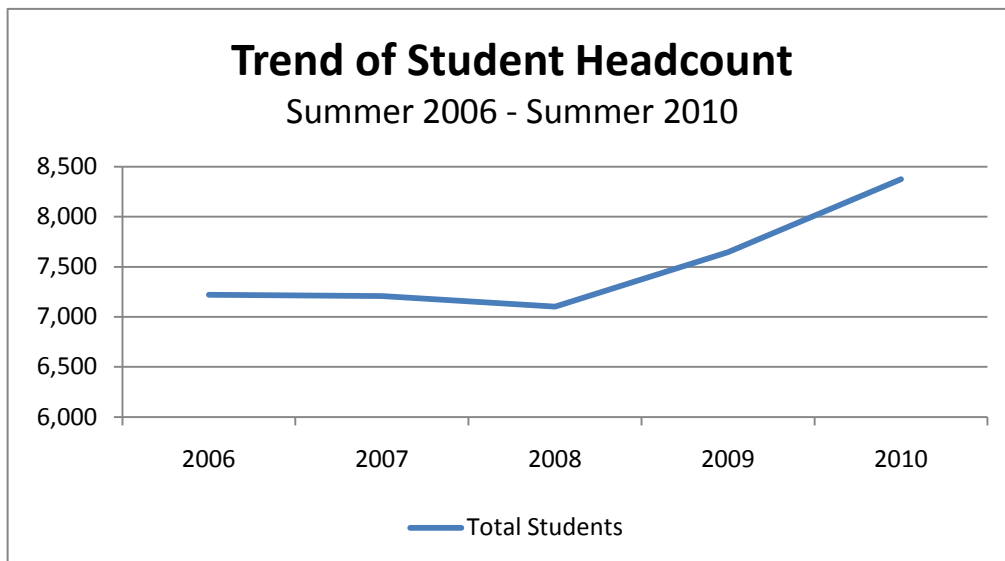

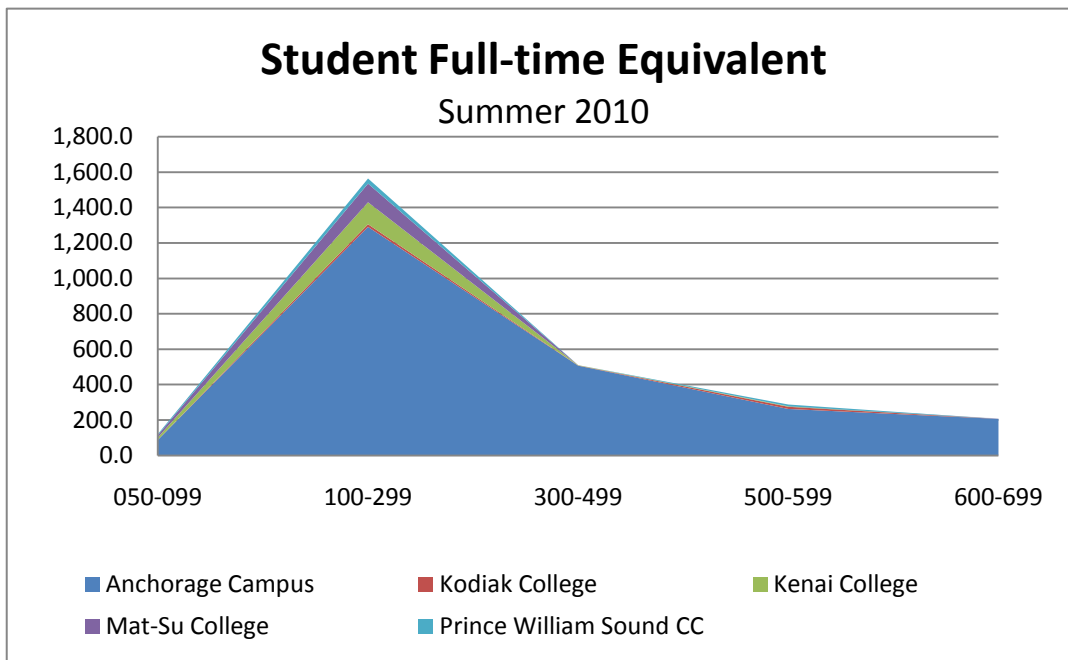
