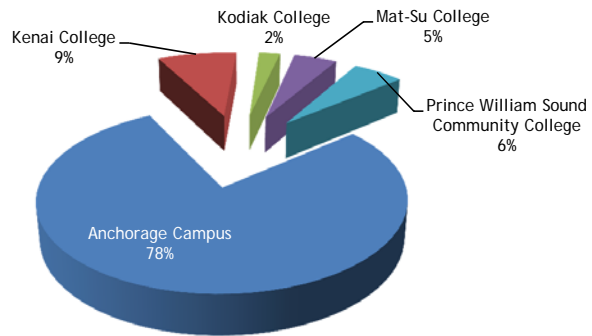

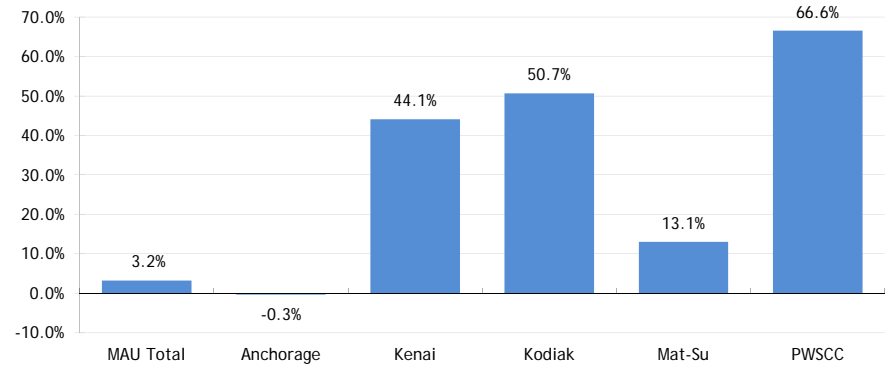

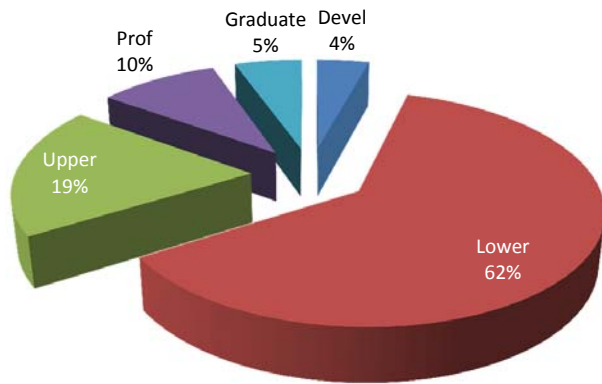
Credit Headcount by Campus
Summer 2011



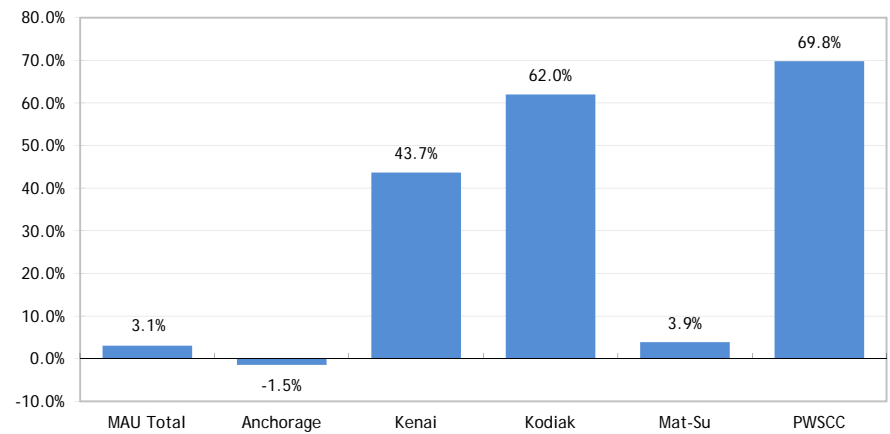
% Change in Credit Headcount

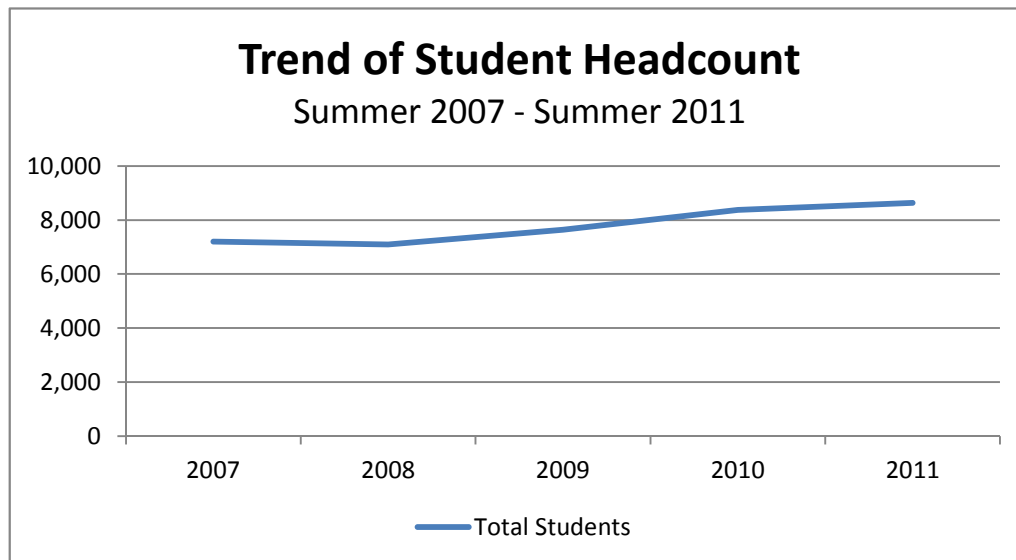

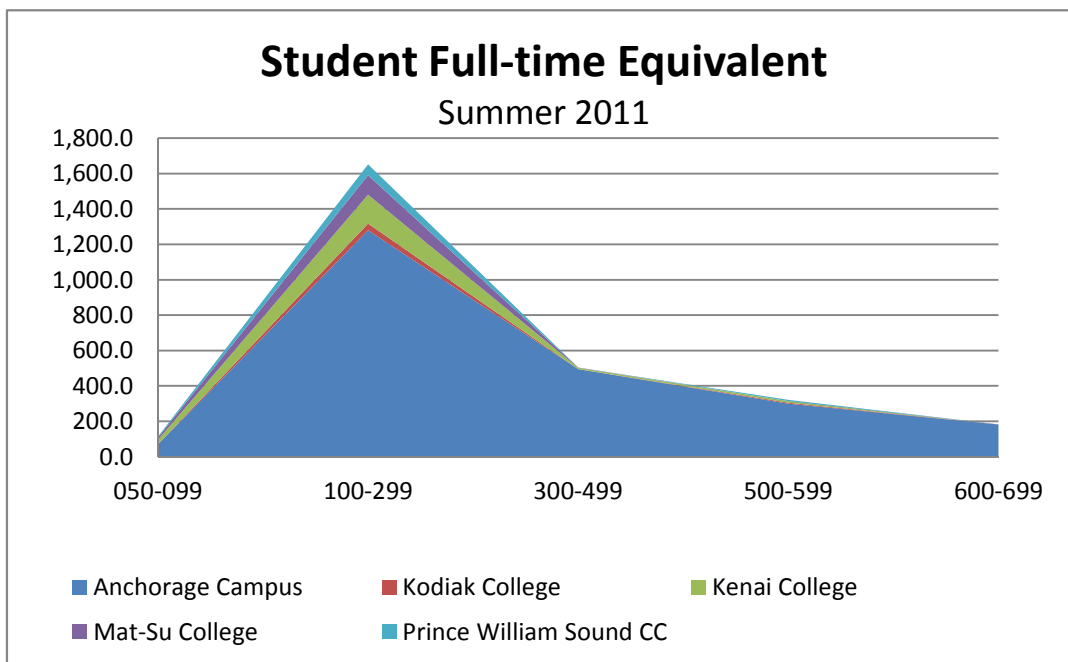
