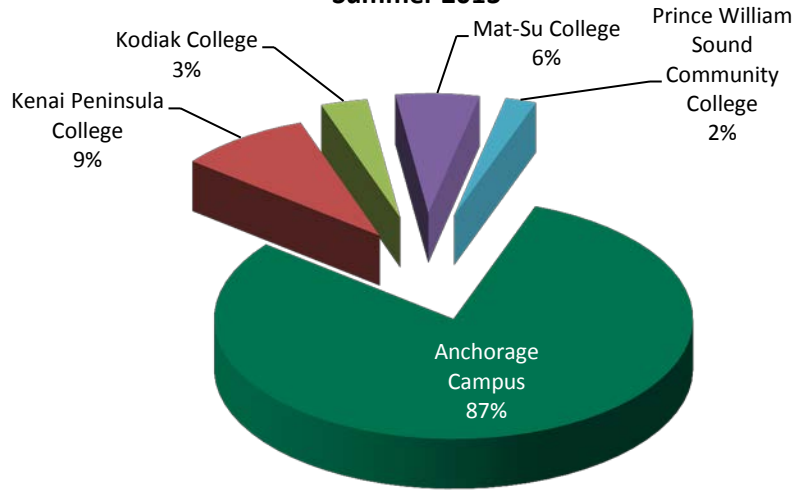

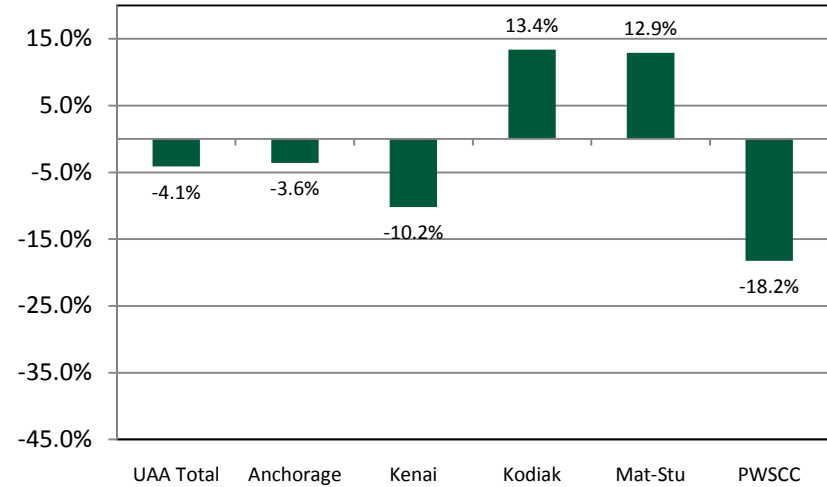

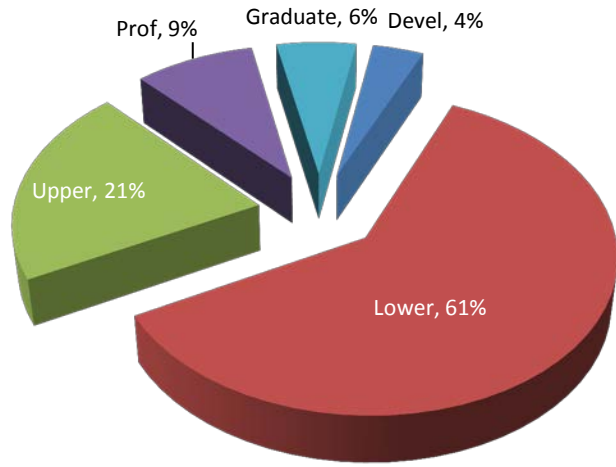
**Percentage of Total Credit Headcount by Campus
Summer 2013**



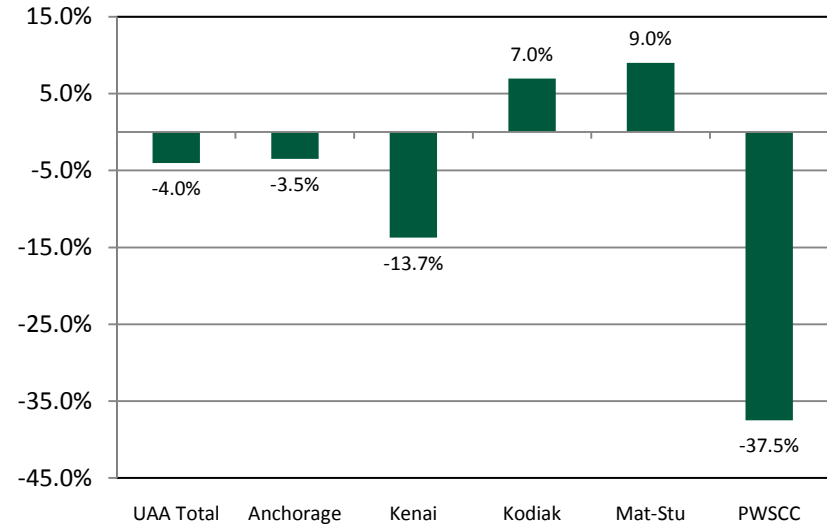
**% Change in Credit Headcount

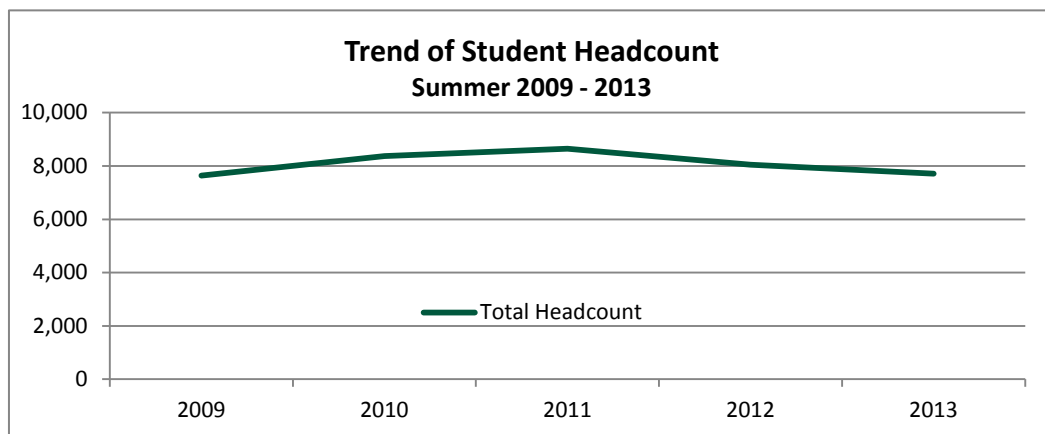

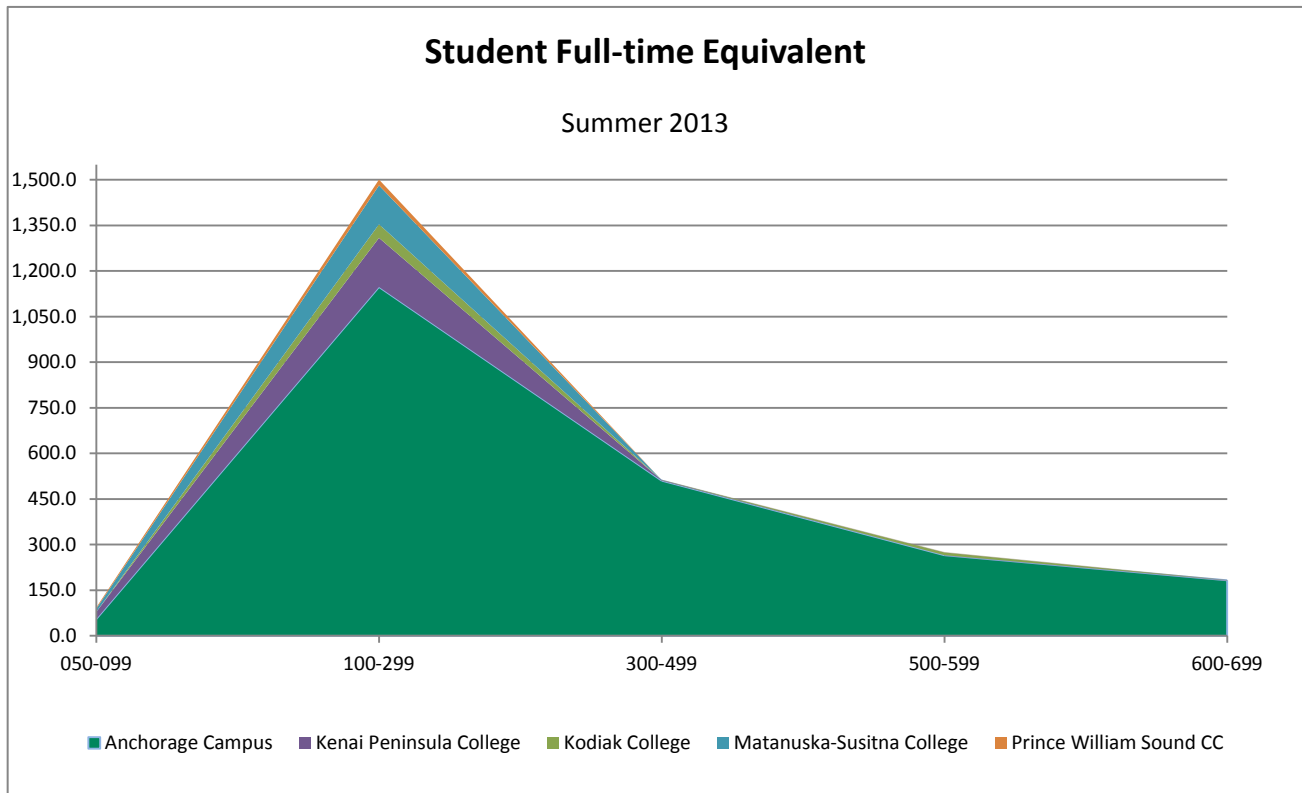
