- Enrollment projections have been set for a 5%-7% of growth between now and FY25.
- Tuition budget is to be built on assumption of between negative 2% and negative 4% percent for fall, college wide. If you think you can be above that in your college send your projections to the Provost.
- Possible return to Campus in late May
 - Soft reopening after May 24th for student facing staff and services as designed and approved through Provost Runge.
 - May 24th-June 24th campus will not be open to the public except those who are working with students new to campus that may not have a Wolfcard yet. There will be logistical issues to figure out for those services.

Claudia Lampman – Fresh Start Update

- 360 students have registered for courses – 550 registrations
- 61% of those were students who had a D or F, 39% had earned a no credit or W
- Of the registered students 50% have a C average, 25% have an A/B average, and the other 25% have below a C average.
- Over half the classes are in Biology, Math, and Writing.
