- Administrative Scholarship Updates
 - They are slightly less than last year's total
 - Dividing the scholarship amounts up by percentage of enrollment.
 - How best to use these scholarships?
 - Financial sensitivity analysis shows the price structure which will attract the largest number of students and what kind of financial aid package will help get them to enroll in courses
 - Data should be available by December, then as a group we will think about next year's distribution of aid
 - Summer Bridge 2022 – the goal is to have an in-person event if possible. Please hold some funds from the Administrative Scholarships from the colleges to participate in this program – more to come soon. Each college will be asked to participate for about 20-40 students at about \$500 a student.
- Faculty Hiring Requests for Fall
 - Please compile your packages of hiring requests – there will be 1:1 meeting with the Provost and then approval to launch searches in the Fall -- targeting mid-September.
- Alaska Native Success Initiative
 - The goal of the grow your own program is to result in a direct hire into a tenure track
 - Affected department faculty and Dean have to agree and be included in the selection process of this program.
 - Requests need to be submitted by September 30th with a two week turn around. October is the goal for launching this program, November at the latest.

- Accreditation metrics reports
 - o Feedback due by tomorrow. Please read it!
 - o IR Director, Dan Campbell is working on editing the observations. What observations are helpful for you to have.
 - o Metric – we need to make sure our metrics are defined clearly
 - o Academic Planning Meetings have happened so we know what each college needs to focus on. As you look at those 1-3 things to focus on this year how will you connect that to these metrics. Metrics are in program review, but our Faculty will not think of it this way. We need to show that it means something to Faculty.
 - o Metrics are unavoidable going into making future decisions. We want to continue meaningful tools.
- OMB performance reporting - metrics and narrative sections
 - o We need stories from the Deans directly. Anything about student achievement, research or Faculty.
 - o We want a more coherent story for UAA and this will be used as the basis for the story going forward. We will send out last years to you so you can review.
 - o The audience of the report are the governors and legislators. This is our chance to tell them who we are and why we need their support as a University.
