Provost, Denise Runge

- Campus reopening
 - August 2nd is still the return to work date
 - Academic Program updates will be posted on the Academic Continuity Website
 - There will be a route of communication going forward
 - Doors will be locked until we are open to the public
 - Messaging about needing Wolfcards to get into buildings – they also need to be activated.
 - Communication going to the students this week.
 - Communication also going during Faculty Orientations, specifically adjuncts
 - Students can get Wolfcards in ESH 8-5 & Library on campus starting August 2nd
- Remote work agreements
 - Currently the policy is that individuals who want to work remotely need to request that through the supervisor and HR Coordinator.
 - Form is under review by the post-covid working group – new form will be communicated broadly.
 - The form can be edited or updated at any time going forward, you can approve for a few months and then plan to revisit.
 - Only Faculty who have no on campus presence need to do the form, not hybrid Faculty.

Staff Council Update

UAA will receive about 40,000 dollars so council is coming up with processes and forms for this opportunity. Drafts submitted at the end of August into early September.
