UAA is a member of the north2north University of the Arctic mobility program. UAA students have the opportunity to go on exchange to select institutions among countries in the Arctic and study a variety of subjects.

Students have the option of going on exchange for fall, spring, or the academic year.


Application Information:

The N2N exchange opportunity is competitive. There are many universities within the north2north mobility program. Students should explore which host institution they are interested in before applying.


Students apply to UAA's exchange program first before applying to the individual N2N host program.
