

Program Description:

UAA is a member of the north2north University of the Arctic exchange program. Membership gives UAA students the opportunity to go on exchange to many institutions in the Arctic in order to study subjects that relate to Arctic studies. *Students have the option of going on exchange for fall, spring, or the academic year.* Students will be provided an official transcript from their N2N host institution.

Application Information:

Students must apply to UAA's exchange program first and be accepted before applying to the N2N program.

The N2N exchange opportunity is competitive. The application for the north2north program should reflect the north2north principles and how they relate to your educational goals.

N2N offers students a competitive scholarship. Students are encouraged to complete the UAA and N2N application by February 1 to be considered for this scholarship.
