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### Catalog Course Description

Explores principles, methods, and materials for teaching young children language and literacy through a play-based integrated curriculum.

### Course Design

- 3 F2F Saturdays for 6 hours (18 hours) Online Learning Modules (27 hours) = 45 hours.
- Readings, assignments, observations, and lesson implementation= 75 hours
- Total= 135 hours
- Meets elective requirements AAS in EC Development
- This course uses a blended elearning format that includes a “flipped classroom”. We will have online learning modules that are housed in Blackboard.

*The flipped classroom is a pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a course are reversed. Short powerpoints, videos and readings are viewed by students at home before the class session, while in-class time is devoted to exercises, projects, or discussions.*
