**Graduate Certificate** or **Masters of Education**  
Leads to Alaska Type B Administrative License

## WHO CAN APPLY?

Any educator with (or eligible for) a valid teaching credential.

## WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE IN PROGRAMS?

The **Graduate Certificate** is designed for educators with a master's degree. The program requires **14 credit hours of core coursework, 6 credits of seminars, and 6 credits of internship** (year-long). State-Approved Program Verification Form issued by the SOE upon completion.

The **Masters of Education** is designed for educators without a master's degree. The program includes the same requirements as the Certificate but includes an **additional 9 credits of foundational coursework**.
