Graduate Certificate or Masters of Education Leads to Alaska Type B Administrative License

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any educator with (or eligible for) a valid teaching credential.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE IN PROGRAMS?

The Graduate Certificate is designed for educators with a master's degree. The program requires 14 credit hours of core coursework, 6 credits of seminars, and 6 credits of internship (year-long). State-Approved Program Verification Form issued by the SOE upon completion.

The Masters of Education is designed for educators without a master's degree. The program includes the same requirements as the Certificate but includes an additional 9 credits of foundational coursework.
