



Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Application Form

The University of Alaska Anchorage is pleased to offer eligible students the Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE). This program offers students claiming residency in participating states, with a complete admission, a reduced tuition rate. WUE students pay 150% of Alaska in-state tuition.

If you accept the WUE waiver you cannot count the time as a WUE student toward the time required for establishing Alaska residency. If you accept WUE tuition rate (declaring residency in a WUE state) you will not be eligible for the Alaska Permanent Fund Dividend.

To be eligible for WUE tuition rates you must fulfill the following requirements:

- Apply for admission and be fully accepted to a degree program.
Be a resident of one of the following states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, or Wyoming.

Provide the Admission Office with two documents showing your address to verify your residency in a WUE state. The following list shows examples of items that meet the criteria:

- Voter registration
Vehicle registration
Enlarged copy of your driver's license or state issued identification card
State (Not Federal) income tax return (yours, or your parents' if you are a dependent on their return)
