

Day One Digital/Inclusive Access Materials: The UAA Online Bookstore uaa.textbookx.com

Day One Digital/Inclusive Access is a course material delivery model where discounted digital content is sent automatically to students on or before the first day of class.

Depending on the school, payment is reconciled as part of a course fee, bursar bill, or automatically charged to a student's account,

Below is important information about these materials at the UAA Online Bookstore.

Cost Savings

The materials are a fraction of the cost of printed materials due to the discounted pricing that is negotiated between the school, publisher, and bookstore.



No separate purchases

Students do not have to make a separate purchase for the materials unless they want to buy an optional loose-leaf print version (if available) to use along with the included digital access.



Courses with these materials are listed on a student's bookstore course page along with messaging on when the materials will be available to them.

Bookmark the eLibrary

The bookstore keeps a record of all these materials and any other digital purchases a student has access to in their eLibrary.

Students can review the materials and access information in the eLibrary (information is also emailed).

To visit the eLibrary, log in to the bookstore website, click the username at the top right, then click "eLibrary."



Payment is reconciled

Students who do not opt out are billed for the materials through their student account.



Day One Access via LMS

Once a student registers for a course, digital access to the materials is available to them on or before the first day of class through their Learning Management System (LMS) or Portal (ex. Blackboard, Canvas, D2L, etc.).



Ability to opt out

If a student chooses not to obtain the materials through the bookstore, they can opt out through their bookstore eLibrary account before the billing date and will not be charged.

Once opted out, a student can opt in again and obtain the required course materials before the deadline.
