Qualifications:

- For a complete list of qualifications, see the Web site
- Participation in a UAA approved study abroad or research project
- Excellent representative of UAA
- Academic excellence, a compelling interest in the study of Russia, and a significant connection between the study or research program in Russia and the applicant's academic and professional goals
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Admission into a UAA degree-seeking program and continuing UAA student
- Full-time student during semester of study/research
- Preference given to applicants majoring in language, communications and/or anthropology. Students not in these degree programs should describe related work (courses, student clubs, work and/or volunteer experience) in the application essay
- Participation in a post-program presentation might be requested
- Communication with the donor(s) about education/career goals

Application Process

- Most current UAA transcript
- Focused essay (see Web site for details)
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from UAA faculty (see Web site)
