## **Learn more about Continuing Education at UAA:**

UAA offers Continuing Education through a streamlined and easy-to-use registration system. Courses and workshops are delivered in the following formats:

- Non-credit: These courses are offered in the areas of career development, continuing education, and community interest. Non-credit courses do not count toward a degree; however, participants may receive a certificate of attendance.
- Continuing Education Units (CEUs): These offerings are intended for career development or personal enrichment. The number of CEUs awarded is related to the amount of time required to master the material. CEUs do not count toward a degree; however, upon successful completion, participants may receive a certificate of completion from the offering unit.
- Professional Development: These 500-level courses do not count toward a degree and provide continuing education for professionals at a postbaccalaureate level.
- Workforce Credentials: A series of non-credit courses aligned with national standards, recognized certifications, or industry-specific employment standards.
  Workforce Credentials do not count toward a degree; however, upon successful completion, participants receive a credential.
- Summer Camps and Bridging Programs: These non-credit programs are offered to youth and adults in specialized topics, from science and math to career exploration and more.
